

No Sew Scallop Circle Coasters with the Big Shot

A gift from your Stampin' Up! Demonstrator

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Supplies: 103439 Big Shot 113468 Scallop Circle Die 114533 Clear Circle Die 122194 Big Shot Fabric Adhesive Roll 121818 Sweet Stitches Designer Fabric 122302 Sweet Stitches Designer Big Buttons 121880 Sweet Stitches Fabric Designer Brads 103179 Craft & Rubber Scissors Iron, Hot Glue Gun, Cotton Batting



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These no sew coasters can be whipped up in no time at all with the Big Shot and our Big Shot Fabric Adhesive Roll. Cut your fabric and fabric adhesive into 5" squares. Iron the wrong side of the fabric to the shiny side of the Fabric Adhesive. Place your square fabric side down onto the Scallop Circle die and run it through the Big Shot. You should be able to run at least two of these at a time.

Cut your cotton batting into 4" squares and run through the Big Shot with the Clear Circle Bigz die. You will need two fabric scallop circles with adhesive and one batting circle for each coaster you want to make



Place the batting on the adhesive side of the fabric scallop. Cover with the other scallop circle making sure to line up the scallops. Iron the pieces together taking care to make sure the scallops adhere to each other on the edges.



For the decorative accent, take one of our Fabric Brads and cut off the prongs. I use our Craft & Rubber Scissors for this. Use a hot glue gun to attach the brad to one of the Big Designer Buttons and to attach the button to the coaster. Way too easy!!!!!
